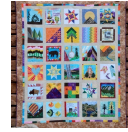

# Cincinnati State Story Quilt



The Cincinnati State Story is a patchwork of experiences. Whether you've been a student, staff member, faculty member, administrator, family member or some combination of those roles, your experiences with the College are part of its 50-year history.

**With the help of experienced quilters (retirees and current College employees), we will create a quilt with squares contributed by the College community.** The Story Quilt is everyone's opportunity to share some part of their Cincinnati State experience through craft.

**If you're interested in contributing a square to this project, keep the following requirements in mind:**

- Your square should represent something important to you about Cincinnati State or your experience with the College.
- It must be made of fabric using any technique you like: piecing, paint on fabric, applique, photos printed on fabric, crayon art, collage, etc.
- The finished square must be 12.5" x 12.5" -- when it is sewn into the quilt it will be a 12" square.
- Your square must be completed and submitted to Abbey Yee by January 21, 2020.

Cincinnati State retirees Debbie Bogenschutz, Joyce Rimlinger, and Diane Stump will be coordinating this effort and assembling the final quilt for our 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Alumni Weekend on May 15, 2020.
