

If you are in college and you need help affording enough nutritious food, you may be able to get SNAP (food stamps), even if you didn't qualify before.

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) provides funds on a pre-loaded card, like a debit card, to help you purchase groceries.

To be eligible, your monthly gross household income

must be at or below:



1 person \$1,383



2 people \$1,868



3 people \$2,353



4 people \$2,839



5 people \$3,324

Each additional person +\$486

As a college student, you must also meet at least ONE of the following criteria:

Attend school less than half-time	Work an average of 80 hours/month
Qualify for a work study program	Care for a child under 6 (or under 11 if a sole caregiver)
Be under age 18 OR over age 49	Have a documented physical or mental disability
