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

Interim financial presentations do include GASB 68 and GASB 75 adjustments. Monthly financial statements are considered interim and subject to change pending certification of the College's independent year-end financial audit.





22.06 FY23 Budget Priorities

- Executive Team recommended, and Finance Committee supports minor changes to ordering and verbiage compared to FY22.
 - Support student success through the allocation of fiscal resources sufficiently to support the College mission and education programs; and
 - Prioritize fiscal support of investments necessary to stabilize enrollment, mitigate aging facilities, and implement strategic planning projects; and
 - Maintain fiscal sustainability and stakeholder compliance as evidenced by key fiscal metrics of: annual positive net surplus, annual positive cash flow, and annual Senate Bill 6 score no less than 3.00 and on a long-term trend to exceed 4.00.



22.07 Budget Amendment

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is required by to Ohio Statute to review and approve the annual budget for Cincinnati State Technical and Community College, and

WHEREAS, approved the Fiscal Year 2022 budget via Board of Trustees Resolution 21.63 on June 22, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio requires that increases in expenditures be authorized by the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the College has generated additional instructional fee revenue and sales and service revenue compared to the budget based on Fall Semester 2021 enrollment; and

WHEREAS, the President, Executive Team and Finance Committee recommend Board of Trustees increase allowable expenditures equivalent to additional instructional fee revenue and sales and service revenue compared to the budget based on Fall Semester 2021 enrollment.

RESOLVED: The Board of Trustees authorizes an increase in expenditures equivalent to:

- \$547,084 (the positive variance in actual fiscal year 2022 instructional fee revenue from Fall Semester 2021, excluding CCP & WDC); and
- \$387,910 (the expected positive variance in fiscal year 2022 WDC revenue due to contracts signed after the
 date of resolution 21.63).

President Posey shall have discretion to allocate expenditures authorized by this resolution, based upon the advice and counsel of the Finance Committee. President Posey and College's authorization to increase expenditures is limited to achieving a net surplus no less than \$606,957 (the amount stipulated in board resolution 21.63), and successfully achieving the colleges fiscal year 2022 priorities related to cash reserves and senate bill 6 composite score. The College's interim financial reporting will be tracked against the budget authorized by resolution 21.63

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22.08 Contract Approval

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees establishes expectations with regards to accountability and transparency, and has adopted a Contract Management Policy.

WHEREAS, the College has complied with Ohio Revised Code, the Ohio Administrative Code, and/or Ohio Revised Code 123.10 in its procurement processes, and in doing so, recommends contracts for FY22 as follows:

 Ellucian Company L.P. License Agreement for ERP modernization (ERP and IT modernization authorized by the Board of Trustees). Term of license agreement 2022-2027. Incremental Cost \$125,905 over 6 years (\$25,181 per year). Total Cost \$3,621,838. Current contract and expense paid with General Funds. General funds or capital appropriations may be used in future years.

IT IS HEREBY deemed that the Board of Trustees of Cincinnati State Technical & Community College approves entering into contracts with the above to provide said goods and services.
